That is a very important question and was actually asked by our heilige *Amoraim* in the Gemara (שבת קיט:). The Gemara tells us that young children are pure from *aveiros* and therefore when they learn Torah and daven it has a greater power than great *Talmidei Chachamim*. It is like a sharp new knife that slices with precision and accuracy compared to an older knife that already has nicks on it. Klal Yisroel needs your learning and davening-keep it up!

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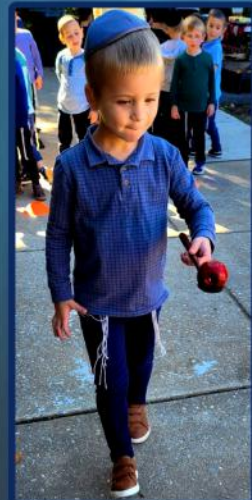

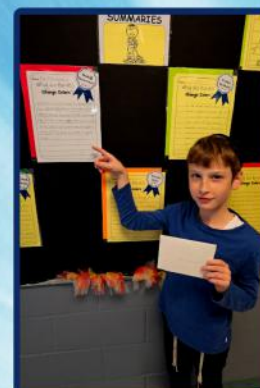
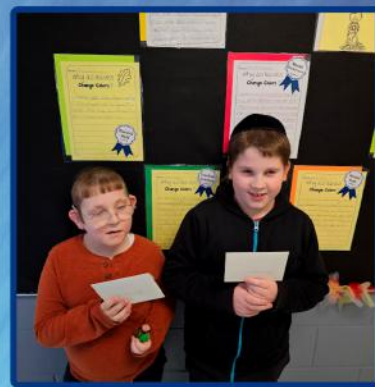


3rd & 4th Grade Success Maker
